The Leibniz Center for Science and Society (LCSS) invites applications for a

University Professorship (Salary Scale W3 NBesO) in Institutions and Processes of Knowledge Societies

to be appointed at the next possible date.

The Leibniz Center analyses the interactions between science and society from an interdisciplinary perspective based on fundamental scientific research and cooperates closely with the German Centre for Higher Education Research and Science Studies (DZHW) in Hannover. The Graduate School 'Science and Society' is part of the Leibniz Center (www.lcss.uni-hannover.de).

The professorship's research will be devoted to the analysis of the interdependencies of science with politics, economics, and society. For this purpose, the prospective job holder of the position will focus on the institutions and processes that shape the knowledge society especially in the fields of science and higher education. The professorship will deal with theoretical as well as empirical research questions and will conduct innovative and interdisciplinary research projects with other LCSS members. With respect to teaching, the professorship will represent the fields of Higher Education Research and Science Studies comprehensively. Moreover, she/he will contribute substantially to the research center's graduate school and the establishment and development of the cross-disciplinary, university-wide research focus area "Wissenschaftsreflexion" (Reflection of Science).

The research center is seeking internationally renowned researchers from political science, economics, sociology, law, philosophy, and related fields. The person to be appointed needs to be experienced in academic teaching, supervision of doctoral candidates, as well as in the acquisition of external funding and needs the necessary management skills for the development of new research structures.

Conditions of appointment are in accordance with § 25, Niedersachsen Higher Education Act (NHG).

Part-time employment can be arranged on request.

As an equal opportunities employer, Leibniz Universität Hannover has set itself the strategic aim of significantly increasing the proportion of women. Female scientists are therefore particularly encouraged to apply. Applications from abroad are especially welcome. Equally qualified candidates with disabilities will be given preference.
